


Conceptually, A Strong Majority of Voters Support Free Trade

Please indicate if you have a favorable or unfavorable view of each of the following... --- Free trade




And that Support is Strongest Among Men and Younger Voters

Please indicate if you have a favorable or unfavorable view of each of the following... --- Free trade




Overall, Voters Believe Free Trade Will Strengthen the U.S. Economy

Which statement comes closest to your view, even if neither is exactly right? Greater involvement by the United States in the global economy...





Voters are Split 38-37 on Whether NAFTA was Good for the U.S. Economy





There is Very Low Awareness of the Trans-Pacific Partnership Among Voters
